## 1 Rizq in Islam: A Complete Vision

Every blessing is rizq.

Allah says that there is no creature on earth except that its provision is upon Him.

This changes perspective completely.

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### Material Rizq

Material rizq includes:

- Food and shelter

Islam does not condemn wealth.

It regulates how it is earned and used.

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## **Invisible Rizq**

Invisible rizq includes:

- Emotional stability
- Protection from harm
- Good reputation
- A supportive spouse
- Righteous children
- Opportunities that appear suddenly

Many people possess money but lack peace.

Peace is rizq.

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## **Barakah: Increase Without Increase**

Barakah is divine multiplication without numerical growth.

Two people may earn the same amount:

One struggles constantly.

The other lives peacefully and steadily.

The difference?

Barakah.

Barakah is not visible on a spreadsheet.

It is felt in stability.

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## **Tawakkul: Real Trust vs Illusion of Control**

Tawakkul does not mean inaction.

Tawakkul says: "I act, Allah grants."

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## **2** Legislated Causes for Increasing Rizq

### 1) Rabbana Atina Fid-Dunya Hasanah

رَبَّنَا آتِنَا فِي الدُّنْيَا حَسَنَةً وَفِي الْآخِرَةِ حَسَنَةً وَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ

abc Rabbana atina fid-dunya hasanah wa fil-akhirati hasanah wa qina ‘adhaban-nar

وَالْبُخْلِ وَالْجُبْنِ،

Allahumma inni a'udhu bika minal-hammi wal-hazan, wal-'ajzi wal-kasal, wal-bukhli wal-jubn, wa dala'id-dayn wa ghalabatir-rijal



“O Allah, I seek refuge in You from anxiety and sorrow, from weakness and laziness, from miserliness and cowardice, and from the burden of debt and the oppression of men.”



Sahih al-Bukhari



This powerful dua addresses internal causes (laziness, fear) and external pressures (debt, oppression). Financial struggle is often both spiritual and practical — this dua covers both dimensions.



Recite morning and evening.

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## 7) Dua for Halal Sufficiency



اللَّهُمَّ اكْفِنِي بِحَلَالِكَ عَنْ حَرَامِكَ، وَأَغْنِنِي بِفَضْلِكَ عَمَّنْ سِوَاكَ

abc

Allahumma-kfini bihalalika 'an haramika, wa aghnini bifadlika 'amman siwak



“O Allah, suffice me with what You have made lawful instead of what You have made unlawful, and enrich me by Your grace from dependence on anyone besides You.”



At-Tirmidhi (Hasan)



This dua protects against desperation that leads to haram income. It asks for dignified sufficiency — not excess.



After prayer and during financial stress.

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## 8) Dua for Ease



اللَّهُمَّ لَا سَهْلَ إِلَّا مَا جَعَلْتَهُ سَهْلًا



Allahumma la sahla illa ma ja'altahu sahla



“O Allah, nothing is easy except what You make easy.”



Provision often requires effort. This dua removes barriers.

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## **PART 6 – ISTIGHFAR & BARAKAH**

Surah Nuh 71:10–12 links forgiveness directly to increase in wealth and children.

Istighfar removes unseen spiritual blocks.

Daily target: 100–300 sincere repetitions.

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## **PART 7 – MISTAKES TO AVOID**

- Seeking magic formulas
- Ignoring practical effort
- Linking rizq only to money
- Expecting instant results
- Accepting haram income

Barakah cannot coexist with deliberate disobedience.
